

Folsom HOG Chapter Riding Etiquette

From the Folsom CA Chapter #1787 Rider Guide

- 1. Arrive at least 15 minutes before the posted ride departure time to ensure you
 - a. Sign in; and
 - b. Attend the ride leader and Road Captain pre-ride briefing.

It is your responsibility to add your name to the Ride List to receive your Road HOG points.

- 2. Have a full tank of gas.
 Gas stops are planned about every 75-100 miles.
- 3. Conduct your TCLOCS inspection prior to arriving ensure you--and others--will have a safe ride.
- 4. Wear or bring weather-appropriate clothes—not just for the departure time, but for the duration of the ride. We often ride in varied terrains, and weather conditions can change quickly.
- 5. Do not assume we will stop at any particular time for a coffee break or lunch break. While we always attempt to make appropriate stops, there may be times that the route does not allow us to do so. Bring a snack or something to drink if you feel you may need something prior to a scheduled stop.
- 6. Use the rest room before departing. As is the case with gas stops, circumstances may prevent a rest stop for a longer than normal time.
- 7. Most importantly, RIDE AND HAVE FUN!
