- 12 Tips for Safe Riding:
  - Ride with people who know how to ride and that you trust.
  - Be seen – remember, brown and black apparel are not your friend on the road.
  - Wear the right gloves – thinner gloves provide better control; heated grips.
  - Never ride tired – stop every 75-125 miles. Stope, stretch, and refresh yourself and your brain.
  - Always keep at least a 20-foot cushion (1-2 second rule) between you and fellow riders. Know how to ride in a group and learn the signals.

- When riding in a group and there is oncoming traffic, be sure and let them know how many riders are behind you.
- Feather your clutch on slower tighter turns and use the rear brake.
- Use the “outside, inside, outside” path of travel in curves.
- Leave room for an escape route.
- Always look where you want to go.
- Be wary of semi-trucks.
- Ride your own ride.
