

Folsom HOG – Road Captains

1. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION OF NEW ROAD CAPTAIN

- a. National H.O.G. status must be current
- b. Folsom Chapter status must be current
- c. Must be in good standing with the chapter and dealership
- d. Must be able to communicate in a professional manner

2. APPROVAL PROCESS FOR NEW ROAD CAPTAIN

- a. Lead a minimum of 2 rides
- b. Ride shotgun on a ride
- c. Ride sweep on a ride
- d. Each led ride must be evaluated by a Road Captain on ride
- e. Each shotgun ride must be evaluated by a Road Captain on ride
- f. Each sweep ride must be evaluated by a Road Captain on ride
- g. Must have a minimum of 1 Road Captain pre-ride with them on the 2 rides that they create and post on the Chapter website
- h. Head Road Captain will solicit feedback (a vote yes or no) from all existing Road Captains about candidate
- i. Head Road Captain will discuss candidate experience and demonstrated skills with observing Road Captains and make final approval decision

3. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR YEARLY PARTICIPATION

- a. National & Folsom H.O.G. chapter status must be current
- b. Plan and lead at least two (2) rides each year
- c. Continue to be in good standing with Chapter & dealership

4. PRE-RIDE BRIEFING RECOMMENDATIONS

- a. "Same for every ride" (Make your own that incorporates all of the necessary items, be consistent)
- b. Must communicate loud & clearly in a professional manner
- c. Be sure to thank everyone for attending the ride
- d. Have copies of ride route for riders
- e. Have sign up sheet with emergency number for each member attending
- f. Verify all chapter members have signed in
- g. Verify all guests have filled out and signed appropriate waiver forms
- h. Go over the route and pre-ride checklist

5. RECOMMENDATIONS ON MOTORCYCLE

- a. Have your emergency information and copy of Road Captain phone numbers
- b. Have copies of waiver forms
- c. Have copies of Hand Signals for New Members if needed
- d. Have First-Aid kit
- e. Have small tool kit
